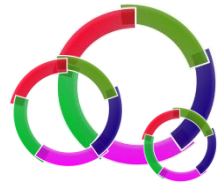


# Round and Round and Round (S)he Sews

## 2017 Quilt Show Challenge Quilt



The theme for our quilt show challenge quilt is ***Circles!***

There must be an obvious representation of a circle or circles in some way. This can be in the fabric design, block design, or quilting design. Circles, arcs, and curves are your inspiration.

### Rules for the Challenge:

1. The perimeter of the finished quilt shall be no larger than 120 inches.
2. Your quilt must be made specifically for this challenge.
3. The quilt must be created entirely by a single quilter and can be traditional, art, modern, or any genre that the quilter prefers.
4. The technique used to create your quilt is quilter's choice . . . pieced, applique, whole cloth, or any combination of mixed techniques. Embellishments are allowed.
5. The quilt must be three layers: top, backing and batting.
6. No material that is copyrighted can be used without the permission from the copyright owner.
7. One of the categories for the quilt show will be Challenge Quilts. Only quilts created for **Round and Round and Round (S)he Sews** will qualify for this category. If you have created a quilt for another guild challenge, it may be entered in any other category to which it applies.
8. A quilt show application/registration form must be turned in with an attached note card describing your inspiration and your quilt technique.
9. Voting will take place at the quilt show in August 2017. First, second, and third place ribbons will be awarded.
